
Did you know that you cannot revoke on the 12th trick? If a revoke occurs on the 12th trick please call the director who will rectify matters.

Defender's Tip No. 2 If you are on lead and you know you could win another trick if your partner had a certain card in their hand, then play that suit as if you know for sure your partner has that card. You will be amazed at how often this will work.
